The tournament is being organised by Brigade Boys Club (UK) on 03rd April 2010.

Rules

1. It's a 9 A side one day football tournament.
2. Each team should consist of TWELVE players and a Manager.
3. The team entry will be in first come first basis.
4. Entry fee is £195 per team.
5. Last date of entry is 25th March 2010.
6. All the teams must report at Information Tent no later than 9am on the day. Failure to do so will be considered as forfeited. Entry fee will not be refunded on such cases.
7. A team which shall not be present on the ground, dressed to play at the time fixed for kick-off or at most 15 minutes later, shall forfeit the match.
8. The rules of the tournament are listed below and will be explained before starting the match by referee/officials.
9. Group draw will be held at the same venue on 27th March 2010 at 10am. Representatives of all the teams are most welcome.
10. Organiser will provide basic first aid kit at the ground but being a voluntary group, we are unable to undertake responsibility for any injury or damage incurred. However, we will be ready to provide assistance within our reach to assist the situation.
11. Organiser will not be responsible for any illegal parking, loss, theft or damage of personal belongings and properties.
12. Organiser holds the right to make final decision on any changes or confusions arisen in the tournament.
13. The team will be expelled from the tournament if any member of the team shows inappropriate behaviour on and off the pitch. Also, the team and the particular individual will be banned from any activities organised by Brigade Boys Club in the future.

General rules of the tournament

1. The tournament consists of 2 stages; Group stage followed by knockout stage.
2. In group stage, each group plays a round-robin format league, guaranteeing that every team will play at least three matches.
3. All group stage games are played of 10 min each half with 3 min half-time.
4. All rounds of matches of each group are scheduled at the same time to preserve fairness among all four teams. The top two teams from each group advance to the knockout stage.
5. Points are used to rank the teams within a group. Three points is awarded for a win, one for a draw and none for a loss.
6. If two or more teams end up with the same number of points, following results are considered in order to determine the position:
 - a. points earned in the matches between the teams concerned
 - b. goal difference in the matches between the teams concerned
 - c. number of goals scored in the matches between the teams concerned
 - d. goal difference in all group matches
 - e. number of goals scored in all group matches
 - f. drawing of lots by Organising Committee.
7. The knockout stage will be a single-elimination game in which teams play each other in one-off matches. There will be again a fair draw for the knockout stage. BBC Cup organizing committee will decide on the length of game depending upon the time constraint of the day and will inform all the respective teams before kick-off.
8. There will be no extra time added in case of draw. Instead, there will be penalty shootout in which 3 players from each team will take. If no team is ahead on goals after these three kicks, the teams proceed to sudden death. If the winner is not decided after all 9 players has taken the penalty kick, it is decided from the method of flipping the coin (head/tail). In case of a player being red carded, it is certain that the team will fail to present a player in the end of the sudden death and the other team is regarded as a winner.
9. Each team must wear their team shirts. We advise to bring away shirts if you have one. When, in the opinion of the referee, the colours of the two opposing teams might lead to confusion, the team losing out in toss must change to away shirts or wear shirts provided by the organizing committee.
10. All the team officials and players are kindly advised to do their parts in a true sportsmanship manner, as the motto of our club "friendship forged from football". However, referees will be showing cards upon the unsporting behaviors and misconduct. Cards will be counted throughout the tournament. Players receiving two yellow cards in two different games will be disqualified to play in the next game. Players receiving red card will be out for that particular game and the next game.
11. Serious misconduct will be discussed by the Organizing committee and officials for further action. Action may include several match suspension or player/team forfeiting the tournament. Decision made by the organizing committee will be final.

This tournament is proposed for friendship among all Nepalese communities through football. BBC would like to thank all the participating team and would promise to continue this tournament for many years to come. Let's make this BBC Cup 2010 a success with competitive, but friendly environment, in the true spirit of sportsmanship, for glory of this sport and our nation
