

### **Tournament Rules**

- Each team should consist of 10 players with the colour jersey and the number at the back. In case of similar jersey, one of the team will have to wear the other jersey provided by the organising official.
- The team entry will be first come first serve.
- Entry fee is £125.00 per team for boys and £100.00 per team for the girls.
- Last date of entry is the 31<sup>st</sup> of March.
- All team must report at the official desk no later than 10:30 am. Failure to do so will be considered as forfeited. Entry fee will not be refunded on such cases.
- Teams must have a minimum of (5) player to begin the game. Any game cannot continue with less than (5) players.
- The rules of the game will be explained before starting the match by the referee/organiser and will be played accordingly.
- Games will start in 5minutes immediately following the conclusion of the previous game.
- Organiser will provide basic first aid kit at the information desk but being a voluntary group, we are unable to undertake responsibility for any injuries or damage that occurs. However, we will be ready to provide assistance within our reach to assist the situation.
- Organiser will not be responsible for any illegal parking or loss or theft or damage of the personal belongings and or properties.
- Organiser holds the right to make final decision on any change or confusion arisen in the tournament.

### **Timings of the Game Period**

- Two twelve (12) minutes halves.
- The game will not be played on stoppage time. The clock will not be stopped if the ball goes outside the court.
- Extra-time periods will be for a total of five (5) minutes with a continuously running clock.

### **Time-Outs**

- Each team will be allocated (3) time outs, i.e. one (1) in first half and two (2) in the second half with no carry over. They will last for a maximum of one minute.
- Although one (1) is available in an extra-time.
- Time-out will be awarded only during the possession of the ball.

### **Substitution**

- All substitutes need to report to the official bench and inform them who they are replacing on court.
- The substitute must be ready to play when they report to the bench (in uniform and ready to enter the court).
- Once they report to the bench, they are to take up a position beside the bench (sitting down) waiting for the referee to beckon them on to the court.
- Substitutions may occur on fouls, time-outs and also in jump-balls. It may also occur if the team is receiving the ball after a violation or receiving got inbound after a successful basket in the last 2 minutes of the second half or in the overtime period.

### **Restrictions**

- 3-second rule
- Travelling
- Double dribble

### **Free throws**

- Two free throws will be awarded when a player is found whilst trying to score.
- One free throw will be awarded for all technical foul. The team awarded the free throw will retain possession of the ball.
- Basket will not be counted if a player touches the line.

### **Fouls**

- A player who obtains his/her five (5<sup>th</sup>) foul during the course of the game will be eliminated from further play in a game.
- Blocking: This covers any sort of contact between two players when an opponent's movement are impeded.
- All technical fouls will count as a personal foul.

### **Technical Fouls, Unsportsmanlike Conduct, Ejections**

- Abusive language or unsportsmanlike conduct towards referee, tournament official or opposing team member.
- Slamming the ball or throwing other equipment.
- A violation of the rules covers such things as an illegal dribble or spending more than three seconds in the restricted area. This will usually be a throw-in.
- Two technical fouls assessed during the game.
- Fighting (at the discretion of the referee).
